Czech minting has a tradition of more than a thousand years. Our country was not only rich in milk and honey – as legend has it – but it also had an abundance of silver. This provided an opportunity for the ancient mint masters to express themselves through art which we still admire to this day.

The Czech Mint in Jablonec nad Nisou has been proudly claiming their legacy for more than a quarter of a century.





Supplier of Czech coins

The entire Czech Republic appreciates the Czech Mint's work. The company has been a reliable partner of the Czech National Bank since 1993, when it was founded.

So far, it has minted more than 3 billion coins. For the state's central bank, it produces all metal coinage clinking in the pockets of Czechs – i.e. CZK 1, 2, 5, 10, 20 and 50 coins – as well as all commemorative gold and silver coins.



World record

For the Czech National Bank, the Czech Mint also produced a gold coin of 535 millimeters in diameter weighing 130 kilograms. Its nominal value is CZK 100 million. The only existing piece is not for sale.

The coin broke the world record – it has become the largest milled coin in the world, the largest gold coin in Europe and the second largest gold coin in the world.



Something for everybody

Apart from manufacturing for the state, the Czech Mint prepares its own issue plan every year, containing dozens of products.

All of these products are notable for their artistic value, craftsmanship excellence, strictly limited mintage and benefits of precious metals. You can find a range of emotions and a thousand years of love of the craft in their reliefs.



Commemorative mintage

Commemorative mintage, sought after mainly by collectors, pays tribute to important anniversaries and eminent persons. Motives on the mintage can be either purely local or downright international.

Investment mintage

Mintage of the "Czech Lion" investment series is intended for the preservation and valorization of financial means.

Investing in the Czech Mint's mintage presents an interesting alternative for those who do not only want to deposit their money in precious metals but who also want to own items of artistic, collector's and emotional value which will grow over the years and which may exceed the value of gold or silver alone multiple times.





Gift mintage

The Czech Mint's gift mintage can find its use at various occasions which call for a valuable present.

These original, yet traditional gifts are designated for newborn babies, newlyweds and alumni, or just for pleasure and, what's more, you can have personal dedication notes engraved on them.



Corporate mintage

So called corporate mintage is made to order by the Czech Mint for business corporations, sports clubs, educational institutions or organizational bodies of the state as well as for private persons.

You can have your own corporate mintage made, too – it will be a prestigious presentation and an excellent gift for your business partners, a benefit for employees, a reminder of an important anniversary or a trading commodity.



Coins or medals

Commemorative, investment, gift and corporate motives can be seen either on medals, or on coins. At first sight, you cannot tell a medal from a coin, however, medals have no nominal value, and as such, they are not a legal means of payment.

The Czech Mint's coins issued independently of the Czech National Bank are full-value means of payment minted under an international license. Therefore, the required foreign attributes can be found on their obverse.



Honorable craft

Every coin or every medal is a result of a long chain of successive crafts – some are modern using the latest technologies, while some are traditional applying handcraft techniques perfected for centuries.

Cooperation with leading academic sculptors, painters, renowned medal makers and talented young artists can result in traditional, original or extraordinary products.





Attractive and practical packaging

The Czech Mint's coins and medals are put in safety capsules protecting them from undesired external influences and then into various packages which are both attractive and functional.

Packages can be made from paper, wood or metal, with added graphics or accompanying text. A certificate of origin is part of each mintage.



Golden savings

The Czech Mint's "Golden savings" is a type of investment in precious metals which is affordable to everyone.

Golden savings, similarly to pension insurance, is effected in the form of regular monthly payments. The Czech Mint does not just accumulate these payments on the account – instead, they are converted continuously into investment coins or bars which are then valorized.
